




Easter Bunny


A rabbit bringing Easter goodies.





lamb


A baby sheep.

Gives us eggs.






chick


A peeping hen's baby.



Cut out the individual cards along dashed lines, fold them and glue.



Cut out the individual cards along dashed lines, fold them and glue.



Has large white or colourful bell-shaped flowers.






grass
