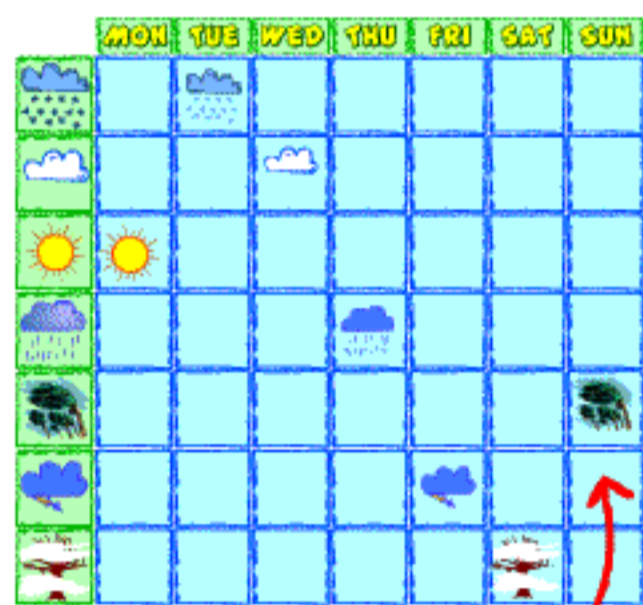


## A BOARD GAME: *Weather Forecast*

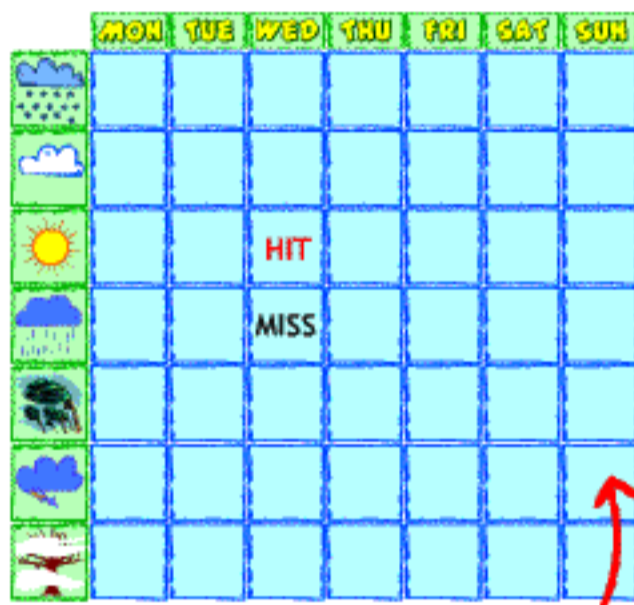
This is a game adapted from the well known Battleships game. Kids play in pairs. Each child must try to find out where his or her opponent's counters are, asking yes / no questions.

### Rules

1. Place your counters on the top of your grid.



*This is your grid for your own counters.*



*Here you try to locate your opponent's counters.*

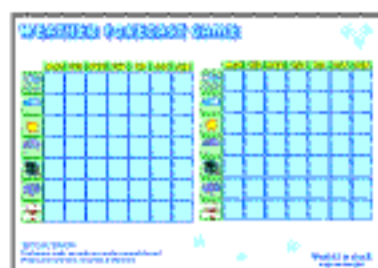
2. Take a turn by asking a question. For example, you might ask: *Is it sunny on Monday?*

3. Your opponent finds the box on his or her grid. If he or she doesn't have anything in this box, he or she says: *No, it isn't. Miss!* If your opponent has a bee in this box, he or she says: *Yes, it is. Hit!*

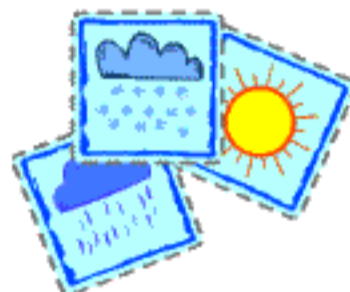
Now it is his or her turn to play.

The winner is the first to find all of the other player's counters.

a game board for each player
















