

A BOARD GAME: *Our Great BattleBees*

This is a game adapted from the well known Battleships game. Kids play in pairs. Each child must try to find out where his or her opponent's battlebees are, asking yes / no questions.

Rules

1. Place your battlebees on the top of your grid.



This is your grid for your own battlebees.



Here you try to locate your opponent's bees.

You need



a game board for each player



a set of counters for each player

2. Take a turn by asking a question. For example, you might ask: *Is there a pink bee in the basket?*

3. Your opponent finds the box on his or her grid. If he or she doesn't have anything in this box, he or she says: *No, there isn't. Miss!*

If your opponent has a bee in this box, he or she says: *Yes, there is. Hit!*

Now it is his or her turn to play.

The winner is the first to find all of the other player's counters.
