

A BOARD GAME: *Where is my teddy bear?*

This is a game for 4 players (or for teams). Each player has a different counter: blue, green, red and yellow.

Rules

1. Say a counting rhyme to decide who starts and who comes next:
One, two, three, play with me!
2. Take a turn by flipping a coin (heads = move 1 space; tails = move 2 spaces).
3. When you land on a square with the bear, answer the question:
Where is my teddy bear?
4. If your answer is correct, don't move.
5. If your answer is wrong, move back one space.

The winner is the first player to reach the finish.

You need



a game board



a coin



a counter
for each player

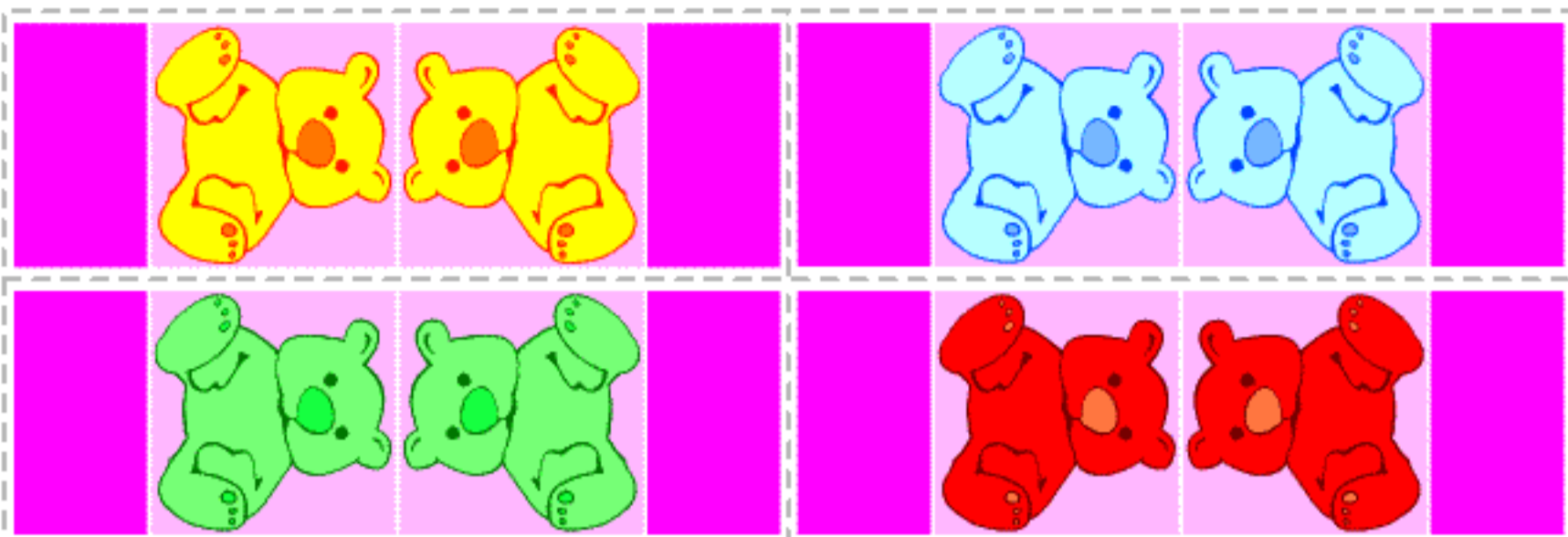


My teddy bear is on the table.



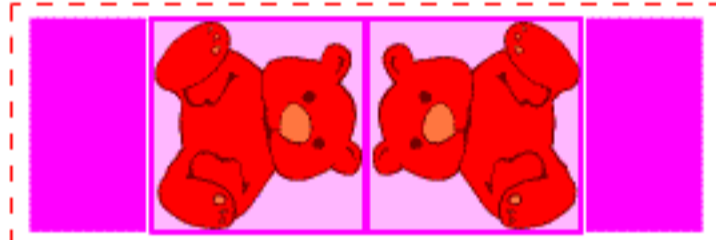
My teddy bear is between the pineapple and the book.

Counters



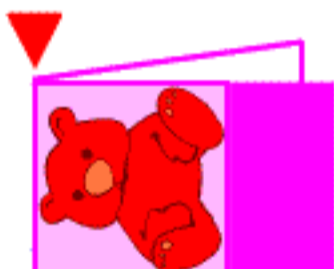
How to make your counter

1. Cut out.

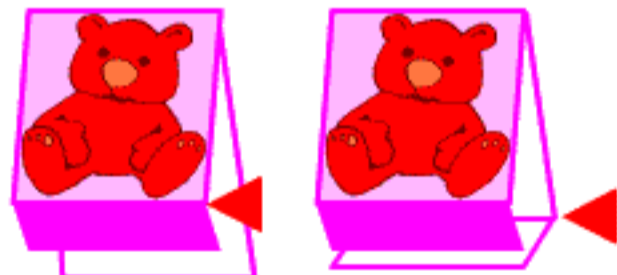


2. Fold.
