

TALKING ABOUT POSSESSION

We use the possessive forms to show that something belongs to someone.

This is Goldie's computer.
It belongs to Goldie.



When we want to know who one or more things belong to, we use **Whose is** or **Whose are**.

Whose computer is this?
It belongs to Blue-Blue.



We use 's after someone's name to show that something belongs to him or her.
