

WHAT'S THIS IN ENGLISH?

This is a game for 2-4 players (or teams). Before playing the game revise or pre-teach the vocabulary used in the activity. To do this, you can use flashcards.

Shuffle question cards and put in a pile face up.

Take a turn by flipping a coin:
heads = move one space; tails = move two spaces.

When you land on a square with the flower, you take a card from the top of the pile. Look at the picture, then ask about it and answer, for example:

*What's this? This is a rabbit.
What are these? They are rabbits.*

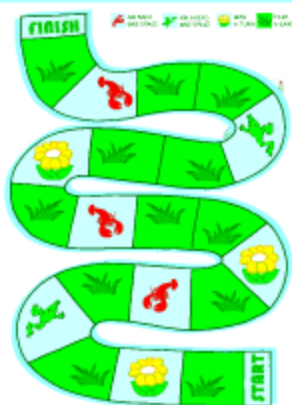
If you are right, don't move.
If you are wrong, move back one space.

The winner is the first player to reach the finish.

Preparation

Print out a game board and question cards. If you want, you can stick the printout onto the heavy paper.
Cut out the individual cards, fold them and glue.
You can laminate your game board and cards for future use.

a game board



flashcards



a coin



a place marker
for each player

You can use buttons
or pawns as markers.
