LET'S EAT!

This is a board game for 2 - 4 players (or teams).

Before playing the game revise or pre-teach the vocabulary used in the activity.

Decide who starts and who comes next.

Take a turn by flipping a coin (heads = move 1 space; tails = move 2 spaces).

You have 10 seconds to say a word related to food and eating that begins with that letter of the square you land on - or you must go back two spaces. Each word can be used once. If you say a word that has been used by someone else, you miss a turn.

If your answer is correct, don't move. If your answer is wrong, move back one space.

The winner is the first player to reach the finish.



D for dinner. Let's eat dinner!



M for milk.
Let's drink milk!

MATERIALS



a game board



a coin



a place marker for each player

You can use buttons or pawns as markers.

If you would like to make your own markers, you can use our templates.

Preparation

Print out a game board. If you want, you can stick the printout onto the heavy paper.

You can laminate your game board and cards for future use.
