

This is a board game for 2 - 4 players (or teams).

Before playing the game revise or pre-teach the vocabulary used in the activity (holiday names and dates).

Decide who starts and who comes next.

Take a turn by flipping a coin: heads = move one space; tails = move two spaces.

When you land on a picture, you have to make a sentence about it. To do this, use the words from the game board, for example, New Year's Day is on the first of January.

If your question is correct, don't move.

If your question is wrong, move back one space.

The winner is the first player to reach the finish.



Independence Day is on the fourth of July.



Cinco de Mayo is on the fifth of May.

## **MATERIALS**



a game board



a coin



a place marker for each player

You can use buttons or pawns as markers.

If you would like to make your own markers, you can use our templates.

## **Preparation**

Print out a game board. If you want, you can stick the printout onto the heavy paper.

You can laminate your game board for future use.
