GUESS MY NUMBER!


This is a question game for 2 players (or teams). In this game, there is one person asking questions (Player Q) and the other person answering questions (Player A).

Before the game, revise or pre-teach the vocabulary used in the activity.

Decide who will be Player Q and Player A.

Player Q gets a game board. Player A selects an envelope, takes out the cards and fans them in his or her hand secretly.

Player Q has to guess the secret set by asking yes/no questions. According to the given answers, Player Q eliminates the pictures on his/her game board until he or she finds out the secret set.



Player Q: Have you got Rosie's turtle? Player A: No, I haven't. Player A hasn't got number 3 and 6.

Player Q: Have you got Blue-Blue's hamster?

Player A: No, I haven't.

Player A has got number 1 or 4.

Player Q: Have you got Goldie's parrot? Player A: No, I haven't.

Player A hasn't got number 4.

Player Q: You have got number 1!

Greengo's Goldie's cat

Goldie's cat

Goldie's parrot

Blue-Blue's mouse

The game can be played on two boards, one for each player. Each player marks his or her secret set of cards, then tries to guess the other person's set by process of elimination.

Preparation

Print out a game board and sets of playing cards.

If you want, you can stick the game board onto the heavy paper. Laminate for future use.

Cut out the individual cards, fold them and glue.

a game board for Player Q



6 sets of playing cards



an envelope for each card set
